## Breakfast menu

### CEREALS – £3.00 each

Porridge served with: Golden Syrup or Jam

Rice Krispies

Cornflakes

### BREADS – £3.00 per serving

Croissants served with:

butter and jam or ham and cheese

Bagels: a choice of plain or onion bagel toasted and served with cream cheese or cream cheese and smoked bacon (or veggie bacon)

Two sweet toasted Belgian waffles served with maple syrup or butterscotch syrup

Fresh seasonal fruit and cream

Toast served with butter and jam and marmalade

### COOKED BREAKFASTS

#### Full English breakfast – £12.00

*Two sausages, bacon, egg, beans, tomatoes, mushrooms and two slices of toast with a choice of tea or coffee*

#### Vegetarian breakfast – £10.00

*Vegetarian sausage, hash browns, tomato, eggs, mushroom, beans*

#### Mediterranean breakfast – £9.00

*Toasted bread brushed with olive oil, poached egg, vine tomatoes, ham, basil*

#### Fish breakfast – £8.50

*Grilled buttered smoked kippers*
